

## Entrance Examination for International Students to Department of Contemporary Business (Business Management Course)

### Eligibility

Eligible applicants must satisfy all of the following:

1. Possess a nationality other than Japanese
2. Likely to receive the status of an international student as defined by Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (of Japan) once admitted by International Pacific University
3. Proficient in Japanese enough to learn and research at International Pacific University (N3 Level or better in the Japanese Language Proficiency Test; certification required)
4. Have completed twelve years of study at school overseas, or will be completing it in August 2018 or in March 2019; and are aged 18 years old or older

Note: Please consult the Admission Centre if you have dual citizenship.

### Scholarship

Excellent applicants may be offered a scholarship based upon their entrance examination results.

### Key Evaluation Points

Applicants will be examined with emphasis on the following points:

1. Keenness to develop proficiency in Japanese and other languages so they can work globally
2. Respect and appreciation of different cultures, willingness to live and work with people from various parts of the world

3. Willingness to understand the traditional Japanese culture and its emphasis on harmony, Japanese work ethics and business manners
4. Compliance with the rules and regulations of Japan; motivation to work with teammates; and keenness to continue self-development and improvement

#### Notes

Entrance examinations for international students at locations overseas, and entrance examinations for international students currently studying at Global Study Centre at International Pacific University, will be conducted separately to the entrance examination explained above.
